

CONSIGNORS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!

Due to COVID Pandemic and CDC Restrictions,
everything has changed!

1-Consignors will pay to Rent a Table/s and we are asking consignors to pre-register if possible.

If registered before October 2:

\$25 for the first table, \$15 for each additional table.

From October 2-October 21

\$35 for the first table, \$20 for each additional table.

2-We are asking consignors to set up and “man” their table. If you are able to run your table or have a family/friend run your table for the sale, a) You would have the option to charge your own prices and the consignor would received 75% of sales, and the YW would receive 25%.

3-If you absolutely cannot attend but have items to sell, you may “rent a volunteer.” Prices on items would come from the Nearly New Price list and Consignors would make 55% of sales, while the YW would receive 45%.

4-Each consignor/volunteer will receive slips of paper with that consignment number on them and those will be filled out and give to shoppers with the total amount from that table. Those slips will then be given to the cashier at checkout.

5-Consignors will also be responsible for setting up and tearing down their space. Of course, we will have volunteers available to help.

6-For Toys/Baby Equipment/Large Items, we will ask you to put your number on those items and they will be placed in a designated space.

Nearly New 2.0 COVID Edition Consignment Agreement

We want to first Thank you for consigning your children's clothing and other children's items in our twice-annual Nearly New Sale. This year's sale is definitely going to be different, so we especially want to say Thanks for your flexibility and open mind as we continue to navigate through the COVID pandemic. This sale helps the YWCA to raise funds for important programs, helps local families save money by buying gently used items, helps local families earn money on items that their children have outgrown, and keeps thousands of pounds of useful items out of our landfills.

NEARLY NEW RULES

1. Since this is a fall sale, we encourage everyone to sell only seasonal clothing.
2. Only clothing for infants and children up to the age of 18 years will be accepted.
3. Items may not reference weapons, violence, alcohol or drugs.
4. Movies and related apparel must be rated "G" or "PG."
5. No Computer Games due to Copyright Issues.
6. Baby equipment cannot be more than 3 years old and must meet current safety regulations. All belts, straps, plugs, etc. must be attached in the proper place and it must be in working order.
7. Toys must be in working condition and include all pieces.

NEARLY NEW PROCESSES AND FEES

1. Consignors will rent tables. If registered before October 2, \$25 for 1st table, and \$15 for each additional Table. If registered between October 2 and October 21, \$35 for 1st table, \$20 for Each additional table.
2. If Consignor works the sale, 75% of sales will go to the consignor, 25% to the YW.
3. If a Volunteer runs the table, 55% of sales will go to the consignor, 45% to the YW.
4. If you do not wish to consign, you have the option to make an outright donation where all of your proceeds will go to the YWCA.
5. If the consignor works the sale, they may establish pricing for their items.
6. If a volunteer runs the table, pricing established by the Nearly New Committee will be used.
7. Consignors will be responsible for items not sold by the end of Saturday. If the consigner chooses not to take items and leave at the YW for disposal, there will be a \$10 fee.
8. Consignors may choose not to participate in the bag sale Saturday afternoon starting at 1:00pm.
9. Consignors will receive a check in the mail from the YWCA about 2 weeks following the sale with their percentage of proceeds from the sale. That check must be cashed or deposited within 180 days. Checks that remain uncleared after 180 days will be forfeited or considered a donation by the YWCA (but will not be acknowledged in writing.)
